

## LONG JUMP GUIDELINES

AGE	GENDER	MAT SIZE	SET BACK	SHOES
U6- U8	Boys/Girls	1 meter mat	Set 20cm back from the pit	No spike shoes
U9-10	Boys/Girls	½ meter mat	Set 50cm back from the pit	No spike shoes
U 11-17	Boys/Girls	Strip mat	Set 2m back from the pit	Spike shoes allowed

## COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- Each athlete is entitled to 3 jumps
- An athlete must exit the pit at the side at any point further than the closest contact point in the sand to the take-off board
- To be a valid jump, the athlete must jump with one foot. They do not have to land with both feet
- No part of the athlete's foot must protrude over the front edge of the take-off mat
- It is a valid jump if an athlete takes-off before the mat
- An athlete must not touch any part of the ground outside the pit during the landing
- Athletes have 30 seconds to commence their attempt
- Powder may be used on the take-off mat for **Under 6 – Under 10 athletes only**, to assist with measuring

### COMPETITION MEASUREMENT- U6-U10 (½ & 1m mat)

- Measurement is taken from the **front of the foot print** on the mat (or any part of print seen) to the nearest break in the landing area made by any part of the body or limbs. Point to point
- If an athlete takes off **before the mat**, it shall be measured to the **back edge of the mat** furthest from the pit and measured perpendicularly
- Measurement is rounded down to the nearest whole centimetre

### COMPETITION MEASUREMENT- U11-17 (Strip mat)

- Measurement is taken from the nearest mark in the sand (from any part of the body) to the perpendicular line of the take-off board and spiked with the zero end of the tape
- If an athlete takes off **before the mat**, the jump will be measured from the nearest break in the landing area made by any part of the body or limbs to the **back of the mat**
- Measurement is rounded down to the nearest whole centimetre

## SAFETY

- After each jump has been made and measured the pit needs to be smoothed out to provide an even surface for the athlete to land in and free from debris
