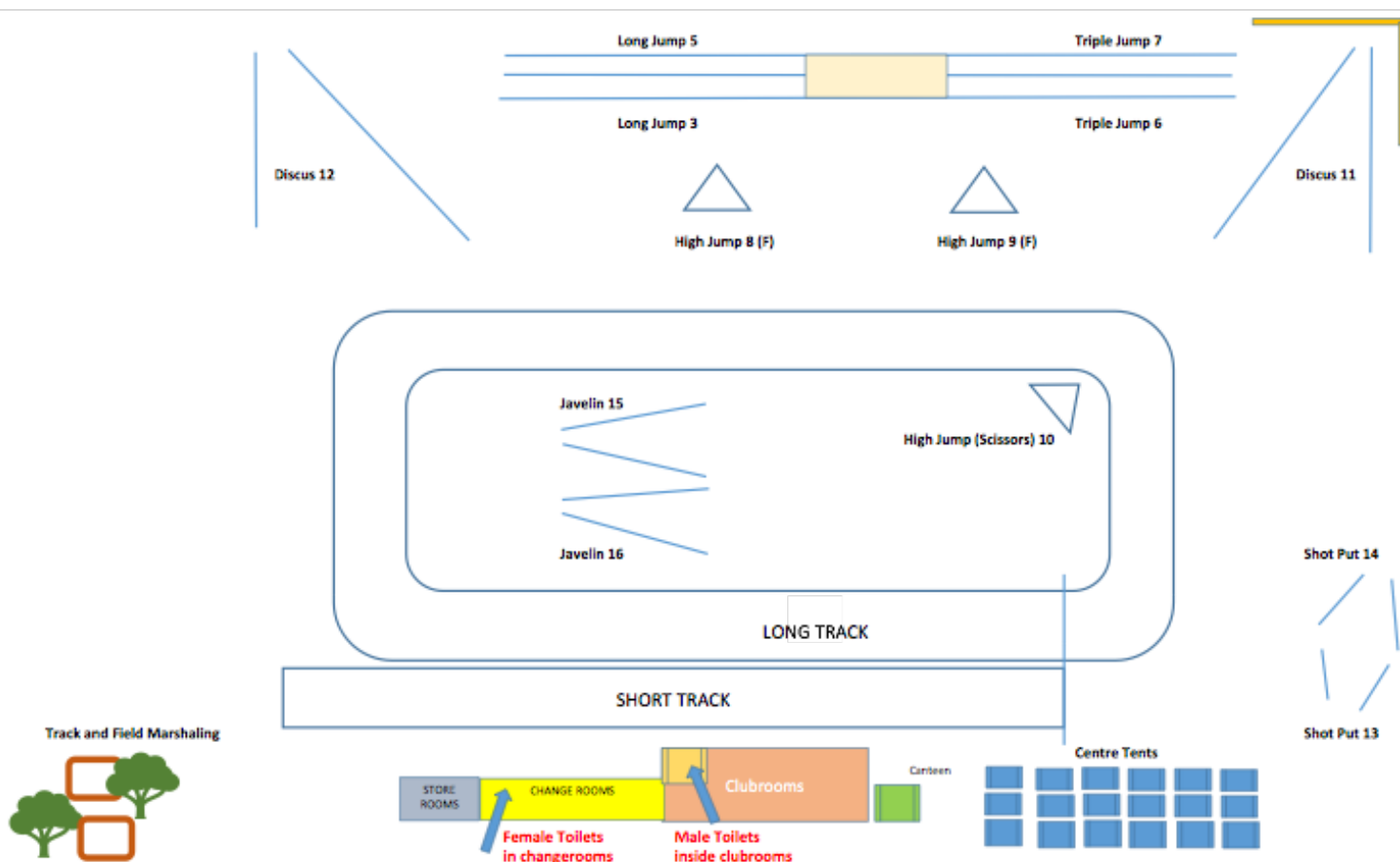
Zone 4 championships @ HBF Joondalup 15-16/2/2020

Dear parents, carers and athletes of the Joondalup Little Athletics Centre (JLAC),

Welcome to the 2020 Zone 4 Championships, which are being held on the weekend of the 15th and 16th of February 2020 at JLAC - **HBF Joondalup Oval**.

Approximately 520 athletes from Zone 4 (including 136 JLAC athletes) have registered for the Championships. Given these numbers, our Club Rooms have made provision for extra female toilets during the weekend at the site (see map).



Safety reminder

For everyone's safety, please note that you are **NOT ALLOWED** to cross/enter the track during competition. Please stay outside/behind the designated roped-off areas.

Unless you are an official with a requirement to be on the inside of the track (i.e. javelin and high jump zones), please also keep away from this vicinity.

Parents/athletes are also not permitted to enter the 'end of track' time-keeper areas (unless their role requires such).

Furthermore please do not bring any dogs/pets to this event.

As per usual programs/special events, the expectation is for one roster to be completed for every competing athlete.

c). Especially if you cannot volunteer/assist on the weekend, it would be most appreciated if a few parents can come down to the Club at **3pm this Friday** for a couple of hours to help with a few **small tasks** (e.g. sort out the long jump pit).
